



Veteran-Cycle Club Website Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy for the Veteran-Cycle Club ('Our Club') will explain how our organisation uses the personal data we collect from you when you use our website.

Introduction

Our Club is committed to safeguarding the privacy of our members and website visitors and this Policy sets out how we will treat your personal information.

This Policy applies to this website, online library, purchases and subscriptions.

Your personal data may include name, address, contact telephone number, username, e-mail address and any other information you choose to share with us.

Please read the Policy carefully and contact us if you have any questions or concerns about our privacy practices.

Who we are

Our Club was founded on 25 June 1955. The aim was to study and exchange information on cycles and cycling history. Club business is overseen by a committee and appointed officers. In the first instance if you wish to contact us please e-mail the Hon. Sec. at: honsec@v-cc.org.uk

What data do we collect?

Our Club collects the following data:

- personal data, name, address, telephone number, e-mail, in connection with membership subscription and renewal. This may include family member personal data. There is an opt-out from publication of personal data in Our Club publications.
- personal data, name, membership number and e-mail address for member access to the online library.
- personal data, name, address, telephone number, e-mail, in connection with online shop product purchase.
- personal data, name, address, telephone number, e-mail, in connection with our research service.
- personal data, name, e-mail, in connection with a general enquiry.
- aggregated information not used to identify you to understand and analyse how visitors use our website and online library and look for ways to improve the service.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Our Club with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- apply online for access as a member.
- provide feedback by e-mail.

- use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

Our Club collects your data so that we can:

- manage your use of Our Club website.
- e-mail you in response to any contact that you may initiate.
- e-mail you as a member with information about forthcoming events and information.

How do we store your data?

Our Club securely stores your data. Appropriate security measures have been taken to protect the data.

Our Club will keep your data for as long as you remain a member of Our Club or until such time as you request that it be deleted. In the event that you become no longer a member we will delete most of your data but retain a minimal record to be able to reinstate your membership number in the event that you rejoin Our Club.

Marketing

Our Club does not knowingly share our data with third parties for marketing or advertising purposes.

What are your data protection rights?

Our Club would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Our Club for a copy of your personal data.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Our Club correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Our Club to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Our Club erase your personal data.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Our Club restrict the processing of your personal data.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Our Club processing of your personal data.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Our Club transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you.

Cookies

Cookies are text files placed on your device to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behaviour information. When you visit our website and online library, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we use cookies?

Our Club uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

- keeping you signed in to our online library.
- understanding how you use our website.

What types of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses:

- **Functionality** – Our Club uses these cookies so that we recognise you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and location you are in. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies are used.
- **Advertising** – Our Club uses these cookies to collect aggregated information about your visit to our website which does not identify you, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about your browser, device, and your IP address. Google, in connection with our online library, may also share online data collected through cookies with their advertising partners. This means that when you visit another website, you may be shown advertising based on your browsing patterns on our website. How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies but some of our website features may not function as a result. You can clear cookies in the settings for your browser. Private browsing, also known as incognito mode, is a feature available in web browsers that allows you to browse our website without leaving any trace of online activity on your device. In this mode, the browsing history is not recorded, and local data related to the session, like cookies and cache, are deleted once the session ends.

Privacy policies of other websites

Our Privacy Policy applies only to our website, so if you click on a link to another website, you should read their privacy policy.
